Home Learning Survey, February 2021 Summary of Parental Responses

Approx. ¼ of families completed survey

- On average children are spending 2hrs or more on schoolwork daily
- Most children complete some work independently and some with adult assistance
- 83% thought it was easy / extremely easy to return the minimum number of pieces per week
- Children are receiving correct amount of work (100%)
- Work is deemed to be of a high quality (89% 4 or 5 / 5)
- Some children are coping well with remote learning (55% 4 or 5/5), but others are finding it more difficult (2/5 rating and 3/5, 25% each)
- Seesaw easy to use (100% 4 or 5/5)
- Parents are quite confident to help their child at home (average rating 3.67/5)
- Summary of responses to 'What are we doing well?'
 - o Work sent ahead of time, e.g. weekly, or evening prior
 - Teaching videos by teachers (not third party)
 - Answers
 - Feedback prompt, positive, encouraging, voice messages very well received by children
 - o Work pack
 - Flexibility to submit work by Friday
- Summary of responses to 'What could we improve?'
 - o Interaction between children, e.g. weekly Zoom session
 - o Teacher explanation videos
 - o Book reading by teacher recorded
- Summary of responses to 'Any other comments'
 - o Parents very appreciative of all hard work
 - o Great improvement compared with Spring 2020 remote learning

Staff have discussed these results and agreed to:

- Include at least one teaching clip, made by the class teacher, per group each week
- Will try to hold a 'virtual meet' session, every other week for children who are learning remotely
